

### **Free training on taxes and taxation for small businesses and non-profit organizations**

*Brome-Missisquoi, November 9, 2009* - The Brome-Missisquoi Centre local de développement (CLD) will be holding three training sessions for the region's autonomous workers, small businesses and non-profit organizations. The half-day training sessions will be held at the CLD offices, at 749 Principale in Cowansville.

On **November 24, 2009** from 8:30 to 11:30 a.m. a training session will be held on **taxation for small businesses**. It is intended for anyone, starting out in business, considering doing so or becoming an autonomous worker, and who wants to know the basic principles of business taxation.

On **December 8, 2009** from 8:30 to 11:30 a.m., a training session on **the GST and PST for a small business** is offered. It will cover the laws concerning good tax management as well as the associated rights and responsibilities.

Also offered on **December 8, 2009** from 1 to 4 p.m., is a training session **on taxes and taxation for non-profit organizations**. It will cover the tax basis, characteristics, rights and obligations for this type of organization.

The training sessions are offered free of charge thanks to the cooperation of the Canada Revenue Agency (CRA) and the ministère du Revenu du Québec (MRQ).
